

Downloading and Installing Software

This video will explain how to download and install software.

Let's start by clicking on the "Download Now" link.

Here you can click on "Run" or "Save".

If you click run the program will be installed from it's current location.

If you click on "Save", you can save it on your computer's hard drive where you can install it from there.

Either way is fine but one reason to save it would be in case you ever needed to reinstall it you could do so without having to download it again.

If you decide to click "Run" then you would just follow the instructions on the screen.

Let's click "Save" and go through this process since there is just a little more involved.

Now choose from the drop down menu exactly where on your computer you want to save the file. This way you always know where it is in case you need to reinstall it at some time.

I often place them in my "Program Files" or "My Downloads" Folder. But for the purpose of this video I am going to put it on my desktop so I can find it quickly.

And click "Save".

Click "Run"

And here I will click "Run" again.

This brings up the "Setup Wizard" which will walk me through the rest of the process.

Click "Next"

Here I will have to check the box that say's "I accept the agreement" and then click "Next"

Click "Next" again.

Now in this box it gives the location on my computer that the program will be installed. If I would rather put it into a different location I would just click on the "Browse" button and navigate to the folder that I would like to place it in.

But I'm going to leave it where it is and just click "Next"

Now it is telling me that it will place a shortcut within my "Start Menu" so I can find it easily. If I didn't want it in my start menu like these here then I would just click the box and click "Next".

It now wants to place an icon on my computers desktop which I do like doing. And this box is basically saying that it wants to associate any zip files on my computer with this program.

I will leave this as it is and click "Next" Click "Install"

And "Finish"

Now if I go to my desktop I will see the icon for the program that I installed.

And here it is ready to go. Just double click on it and start using it.
